


Example – Lambert Park Alpine, Utah

PROPOSED MAP and LOOPS.


Three Loops now with a potential 4th loop in the future –

Advanced Loop

Will be a 2 mile loop and will be on the South East corner of the park. Will be good for running, hiking and cycling. Challenging switch backs and downhills with a few obstacles.



Intermediate Loop

About a 1.5 mile loop with fun flowing single track in the western area of the park.



Beginner Loop

About 1/2 a mile loop located closer to the creek in the center of the park. A great mellow flowing trail to get kids learning how to ride bikes off road.

There will be a sign at the bridge giving everyone a map of the loops and mileage along with safety tips and trail etiquette rules.
