City of Highland East-West Collector Road Recommendations October 1989

- 1. Visit with Tri-City Golf Course Board of Directors regarding viability of Alternative No. 1 and identify mitigation requirements and costs.
- 2. Visit with county Parks Department to identify options and costs for mitigating impacts to Adventure & Learning Park.
- 3. Discuss possibility of cost sharing with UVATS Committee.
- 4. Hold public meeting to present alternatives and get public input (invite all parties impacted not just Highland residents (i.e. Golf Course, Adventure & Learning Park).
- 5. Select preferred alternative for East-West collector.
- 6. Perform a preliminary survey to tie down alignment in field.
- 7. Develop official city street map which includes existing and proposed streets (Utah Municipal Code 12.212-12.215). (Include East-West Collector and other collector and arterial roads)
- 8. Hold public hearing for official city street map (Utah Municipal Code 12.213).
- 9. Adopt official map.
- 10. Provide an ordinance which prohibits issuance of building permits for structures on land which is part of any street shown on the official map.
- 11. Review all future building permits and subdivision plats to ensure that they will not conflict with official street map (Utah Municipal Code 12.212 and 12.215).
