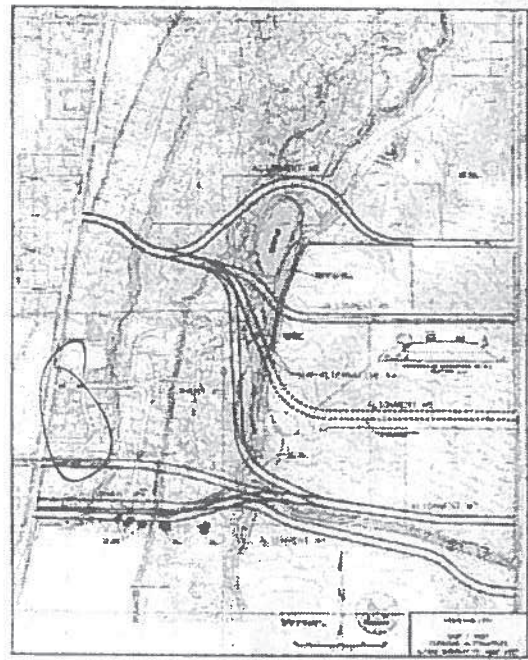


**Highland City**
